Many volunteers have met for the preparation to bring these goods to Nepal several times. They packed the donated goods in a thousand of bags, thinking what goods children in Nepal would be delighted. Even the volunteers, which were not going to Nepal in this time, they felt like they flight to Nepal to see the children. As a result, they were packed in 6 cardboard boxes, 98 kg; heart of everyone!

Kite Flying in Samdibesi Village



In Samdibesi Village, the students cordially welcomed the visitors with smile and hand-made leis. The volunteers delivered the bags including notebooks, crayons, paint tubes, and sweets to approx. 4 hundreds students. The students looked shy but they had shining eyes and said with folded palms, 'Namasute'.

Some students shared the bags opened each other with happy look on the way home from school!

The volunteers and higher-grade students played with hand-made kites on roof of the school building together. Unfortunately, it was not windy, but everyone tried to fly kite climbing on the place as high as they could. When the kites flied very high

up in the sky and kite strings twined each other, they squealed for joy and surprise.

In the kinder class, the children, volunteers, and women in the village had fun to sing and dance with castanets brought from Japan.

Talked the story when Atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima

A member of the volunteers told high-grade students and teachers about the story when Atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima. On August 6, 1945, A-bomb was dropped above the center of Hiroshima City, and the city was in crippling damage. Approximately 200 thousand people were died at the moment. The volunteer appealed the world peace, talking how scared the bomb was. The English edition of 3 books, titled 'Hiroshima', were presented for the school. Hoping the world peace without war...

Lecture of AIDS

The English edition of leaflets regarding AIDS was delivered to all the teachers. The volunteers explained symptom of AIDS, infection, how to handle AIDS victims without prejudice and discrimination. They also requested the teachers to tell high-grade students about the same as lectured.

L Angel would like to appeal the importance of prevention and continue this activity as AIDS victims increase around the world.

Enjoyed Time at school

Kinder class 2nd grade (Drawing paint)

The students drew colorful painting with various colors of paint tubes and crayons brought from Japan.

1st grade (Origami craft)

The students folded many Kabuto-helmets and paper cranes. The volunteers helped them origami how-to and enjoyed watching students wore the Kabuto or played with the Japanese cranes.

3rd, 4th, and 5th grade (Radio gymnastic excise and playing balls)

The students played balls. L Angel School does not provide gymnastic excise course, so students had to learn the rules of ball games. They quickly learned how to kick balls and even created their own play rules. Everyone enjoyed it.

College student and volunteers gave a Japanese song lesson a radio gymnastic excise using music tapes and lyrics on a large paper brought from Japan. It was a good communication between volunteers and school students.

6th and 7th grade (Kite flying)

Many students tried to fly kites on roof of the school building with joy, although it was crowded. After while, some students asked volunteer to bring the kite home. A volunteer told them it is OK, and they kept the kite protectively. When they go home, they were going to enjoy kite flying with their brothers.

8th and 9th grade (Craft of glider)

Students and volunteers struggled with gliders crafts, because it was hard to make. Even when bell of finishing lesson rang, they continued until the crafts were completed. Everyone looked so delighted at flying gliders on the school playground.

Started workshop of support of caring mind for disabled persons and families

L Angel has started to support mind care for disabled persons and their families, under the assistance of Welfare And Medical Service Agency.

The first session was held on Sunday, April 23, 2006. After the opening ceremony, the parents or caregivers experienced 'Naikan'. During the time, the children enjoyed various workshops such as music instruments, paint drawing, bowling. Every child spent wonderful time with volunteer staff, eating snacks.

We are planning to hold this kind of session for 12 times until March, 2007. In the first session, we had something to be improved and attempted newly, in order to make the sessions more successful.

In order to make sure security for 62 participants, we confirmed the escape route for disaster. We recognized how to lead to emergency exit and stairs in the building, and the existence of the good place to escape (There was a huge park close to the building.). Thanks to the volunteer staff, the first session was finished without any accident. Thank you very much.

The children entering L Angel child home, an orphanage in India, having been doing regular physical examination, because it is the most important to remedy disease as soon as possible if they have disease. It is also necessary to protect them from group infection.

In this time, 1 child entered the hospital due to tuberculosis.

Other than that, 3 children escaped from the home. The reason was that it was hard to go to school and learn.

As we described in the former report, vol. 32, our concerns became true. We recognize it is a hard work, and we have to plan and promote this project thoughtfully without being impatient, keeping children's happiness in mind. Our assistance of orphans has been promoting slowly but steadily.

In June, 2006, the real orphanage is going to be completed. We are looking forward to be completion; we have the troubles such rainy season and labors, though.
